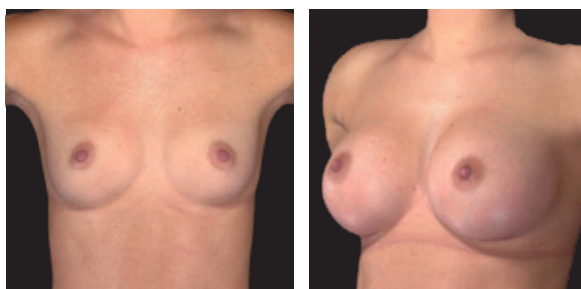
Dr Raja Sawhney and his Sculpted Clinic team are committed to providing optimal care and the very latest advancements in personalised cosmetic techniques.
